This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey approval of the Board for Affiliation Up to Secondary Level as per details given below :

SL. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 12. Further, the increase of section(s) shall be subject to specific approval of the Board based on the request of the school as per Affiliation Bye-Laws and subject to the availability of room(s) with an area greater than or equal to 500 sq ft.
2	The school has a composite science lab. However, it has no exhaust fan, no DO and DO NOT chart, and no safety arrangements. Cloth curtains are seen on windows which are a fire hazard and should be removed. The Composite Lab has not been developed as per the respective SOPs issued by the Board. Hence, the School is directed to upgrade it as per its SOP issued by the CBSE and submit the compliance in the SARAS portal within the next 3 months with video graphic proof.
3	The level of the ramp at the entrance and surface does not match (ref. RC video time 40:57) and the ramp cannot be accessed by the CWSN student. The ramp is steep around 75 degrees (ref. RC video time 42:55). The school does not have a proper ramp for CWSN students. The ramp does not have railings for the safety of students. There is no ramp to enter classrooms, labs, and the library. The school has not followed guidelines issued by the Board for CWSN. The School did not develop its ramp as per the RPWD Act 2016. Hence, the School is directed to construct/rectify it as per its

	SOP issued by the CBSE and submit the compliance in the SARAS portal within the next 3 months with video graphic proof.
4	The school has a computer lab with 30 computers with Broadband connection. However, the software installed in the computer is outdated and needs to be renewed and developed as per the respective SOPs issued by the Board. Hence, the School is directed to upgrade it as per its SOP issued by the CBSE and submit the compliance in the SARAS portal within the next 3 months with video graphic proof.
5	There are only two CWSN toilets for Boys and Girls separately in the School which is not sufficient for a school with G+1 Building floors as per norms of the RPWD Act and guidelines (https://saras.cbse.gov.in/SARAS/Circulars/Circular05_2023.pdf) issued by the Board. Further, the toilets have a narrow passage and wheelchair is also not able to enter inside. Hence, the School is directed to construct/rectify it as per its SOP issued by the CBSE and submit the compliance in the SARAS portal within the next 3 months with video graphic proof.
6	The school does not implement EPF Facilities for teachers and staff. Hence, the School is directed to ensure it as per its SOP issued by the CBSE and submit the compliance in the SARAS portal within the next 3 months with documents.
7	The School does not have a concrete boundary wall in all four (especially on the front side of the Boundary wall) sides of 6 feet in height. Due to its design, it does not cover a height of 6 feet on all sides. Hence, the School is directed to construct/rectify it as per its SOP issued by the CBSE and submit the compliance in the SARAS portal within the next 3 months with video graphic proof.
8	The math lab is seen as poorly stocked with a few models/kits arranged on a small table. There are no workspaces for students; no proper seating and storage arrangements are available in the School. It has not developed as per the respective SOPs of the Board. Hence, the School is directed to upgrade it as per its SOP issued by the CBSE and submit the compliance in the SARAS portal within the next 3 months with video graphic proof.
9	The school shall conduct training of its concerned teachers with CoE, Chandigarh within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE.

All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.

7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
